



The Schneeberg rises proudly 80 km south of Vienna - on clear days you can even see the imposing massif from the federal capital. We have been transporting guests up to an altitude of 1,800 meters since 1897.

From the train station in Puchberg, the cog railway climbs 1,227 meters in altitude to its final stop, Hochschneeberg station. During your journey with the Salamander trains (approx. 40 minutes) or the Nostalgia steam train (approx. 90 minutes) you can take in magnificent views while the landscape passes by, changing with every meter of altitude. Look forward to a day full of nature, enjoyment and history on the highest mountain in Lower Austria.

SALAMANDERPLATZ & KAISERRAST

EMPRESS ELISABETH MEMORIAL CHURCH

Emperor Franz Joseph I commissioned the construction of this small mountain church in memory of Empress Elisabeth in 1901. Built in an Art Nouveau style from stones of the Schneeberg, it still hosts mountain masses, baptisms and weddings.

Schneeberg hiking paradise

With more than 80 km of hiking trails and alpine climbs, Puchberg is one of the most beautiful hiking areas in Lower Austria. The Hochschneeberg mountain station is the ideal starting point for many exciting hikes on and around the Schneeberg.

PLATEAU HIKE

This 7 km long, moderately difficult hiking trail leads from the mountain station to the summit of the Schneeberg at 2,076 m above sea level (approx. 2.5 - 3 hours walking time). Refuel with hearty regional delicacies at the Fischerhütte.

ZAHNRADBAHN HIKING TRAIL

The approximately 10 km long, moderately difficult hiking trail also starts at the mountain station of the Schneebergbahn

The hike leads via the Baumgartner stop, the Kaltwassersattel, the Hengsthütte and the Hauslitzsattel down to Puchberg am Schneeberg (approx. 3 hours walking time).
